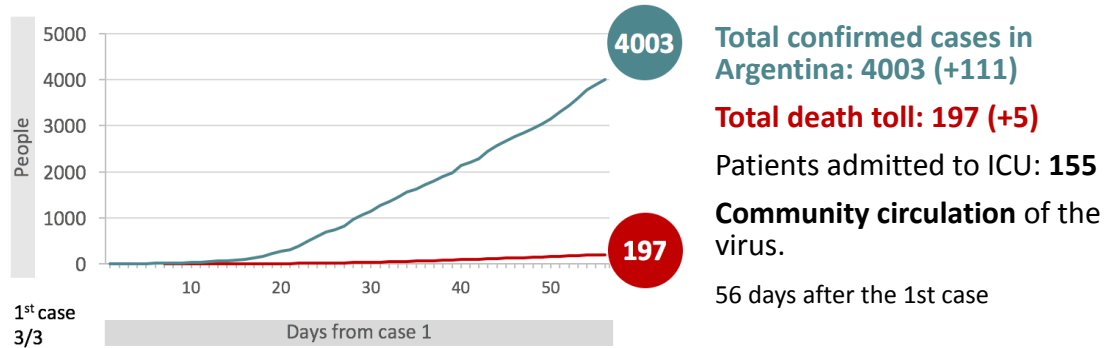

## LATEST MEASURES BY THE ARGENTINE GOVERNMENT

- **04/26/2020 [Decree 408/2020](#)** The preventive and mandatory social isolation is extended until May 10. Governors may decide exceptions under certain conditions determined by the National Government.
- **04/26/2020 [Decree 409/2020](#)** The entry ban to the national territory of non-resident foreigners is extended until May 10
- **04/20/2020** The obligation to use masks in the Province of Buenos Aires comes into effect.
- **04/15/2020** As of today, wearing a mask is mandatory in Buenos Aires City.
