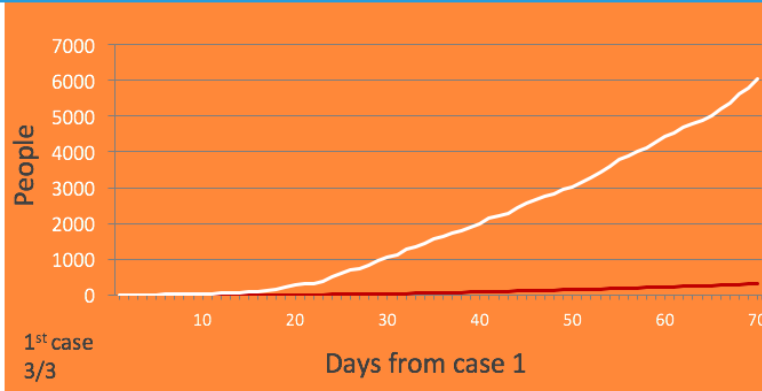

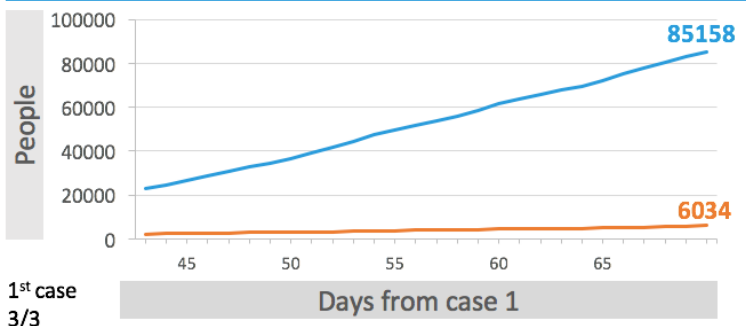

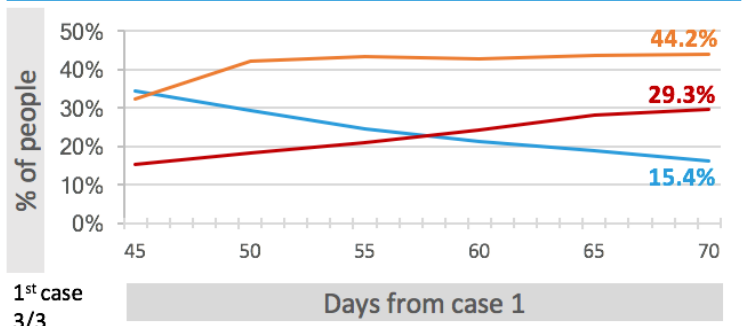

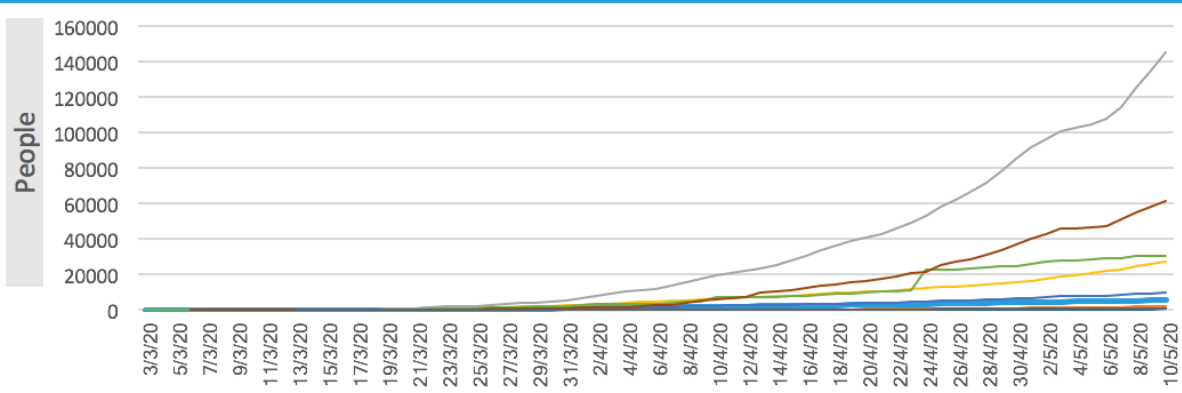

LATEST MEASURES BY THE ARGENTINE GOVERNMENT

- **05-11-2020 - Extension of Preventive and Mandatory Social Isolation.** The preventive and mandatory social isolation was extended up to and including May 24. New exceptions were established due to geographic segmentation and number of inhabitants, incorporating industrial or commercial activities as appropriate and requiring different levels of approval. The bans on face-to-face classes, public and private events, intercity, interjurisdictional and international passengers transportation, tourist activities, etc. are maintained.
- **05-11-2020 - Communication on next steps for a new lockdown phase in the City of Buenos Aires.** A protocol for the gradual opening of activities (local businesses) was proposed, coordinated with the National Administration and the Government of the Province of Buenos Aires and subject to evolution assessments. The opening of shops depends on the number of workers involved and their commuting distance, to avoid public transport.
